## WHO WE ARE:

On February 14th, 2018 daughter Jaime Guttenberg, along with 16 other victims at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School, was tragically murdered by a troubled former student. She was only 14-years-old. Orange Ribbons For Gun Safety (ORFGS) is a nonprofit organization that was created by Jaime's parents in order to lobby, promote through advocacy, and create awareness for common-sense gun reform.

## WHAT WE DO:

- Support, partner, and collaborate with organizations and individuals that agree with the need for common-sense gun reform.
- Advocate, educate and create awareness about the dangers of gun violence and the need for common-sense gun reform.
- Work to prevent other communities from being impacted by every day gun violence, mass shootings, and suicides.
- Work to reduce the approximate 40,000 gun related deaths per year.
- Advocate for comprehensive gun violence policies and strategies that will help to reduce the incidence and lethality of gun violence in America.

## POLICY PRIORITIES

1. Enhanced Background checks by closing dangerous loopholes
2. Background checks for purchasing ammunition (Jaime's Law)
3. ERPO – Extreme Risk Protection Orders or Red Flag Laws
4. Safe storage requirements (Ethans Law)
5. Raising the age of purchasing a gun to 21 years old
6. Funding of CDC to study this public safety and health crisis
7. Repeal Protection of Lawful Commerce in Arms Act (PLCAA) to eliminate the liability protections that has been used to shield firearms manufacturers and dealers
8. Reduce the ability to print and distribute 3D weapons
9. Banning bump stocks and high capacity magazines
  - *Federal bump stock ban went into effect March 26, 2019*
  - *High capacity magazines are illegal in only a few states*

## JAIME'S LAW

Fred Guttenberg, the father of Parkland victim Jaime Guttenberg, is introducing "Jaime's Law" aimed at curbing gun violence through a new type of background check.

On March 3, 2019, U.S. Senator Richard Blumenthal (D-CT) and U.S. Representative Debbie Wasserman Schultz (FL-23) introduced common-sense, bicameral legislation to implement instant universal background checks for the sale of gun ammunition. The Ammunition Background Check Act will be known as "Jaime's Law" in honor of Jaime Guttenberg.

Blumenthal, Wasserman Schultz, U.S. Senator Chris Murphy (D-CT), U.S. Representative Ted Deutch (FL-22) and other members of Congress were joined at a press conference in Washington, by Fred Guttenberg, Jaime's father, as they announced the bill.

He is regularly in Washington DC working with a bipartisan group of legislators in the House and Senate and traveling the country to work with a bipartisan group of Governors and Attorney Generals. Fred has been a loud and strong voice on media talking about the reality of gun violence.
