

Orange Ribbons For Jaime (ORFJ) is a 501(C)(3) foundation whose purpose is to support causes important to Jaime in her life but also causes that will deal with the way her life was tragically cut short. We will look to make donations in the world of performing arts, to organizations that deal with bullying as well as supporting children with special needs.

WHO WE ARE:

On February 14th, 2018 Fred and Jennifer's Guttenberg 14-year-old daughter Jaime, along with 16 other victims at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School, were tragically murdered by a troubled former student. ORFJ is focused on supporting programs that were important to Jaime, as well as those dedicated to pursuing common sense gun safety reforms.

WHAT WE DO:

Jaime cared deeply about helping kids with disabilities, standing up for the underdog and she loved animals. With this in mind, ORFJ has identified Jacob's Pillow, Paley Institute, and Broward County Humane Society as initial organizations to support. In addition to supporting programs that were important to Jaime, we will also pursue educational opportunities across the country on gun safety and the ways that we can work together to make our communities safer.

BRINGING ABOUT CHANGE:

Change happens in a myriad of ways. For ORFJ, we help assist other organizations to ensure that they can have the necessary funds needed to promote programs, give aid or make a difference in the lives of the people/animals they help support.

The Paley Foundation was founded to further Dr. Paley's mission of transforming the lives of children and adults who suffer from rare and challenging congenital, developmental and post-traumatic orthopedic conditions throughout the United States and the world. They advocate for limb saving and life-changing, proven medical treatments that emphasize reconstruction over amputation.
